

## Covid test possibilities for guests in Piesendorf Niedernsill

### Antigen tests or PCR gargle test - free of charge

Supervised **rapid antigen tests** (valid for 24 hours) or **PCR gargle tests** (valid for 72 hours) are available at Red Cross testing stations in all districts.

- **Registration required** at [www.salzburg-testet.at](http://www.salzburg-testet.at)
- When you **register online**, you will receive a **QR code** on your mobile phone.
- **Bring with you for the test:** QR code and valid photo ID
- **Note:** For guests without a smartphone - please call 1450 to make an appointment and bring a valid photo ID with you
- **FFP2 face mask** are obligatory in the test room!
- **Test information:**
  - Anterior nasal swab or gargle test under the supervision of trained staff members
  - **Rapid antigen test:** prompt evaluation by staff on-site
  - **PCR gargle test:** laboratory analysis within around 24 hours
  - **Certificate** to mobile phone with link to print. If a certificate is required (no internet access, no mobile phone ...) please ask at the test station.
