

Natural jewel „Wiegenwald“

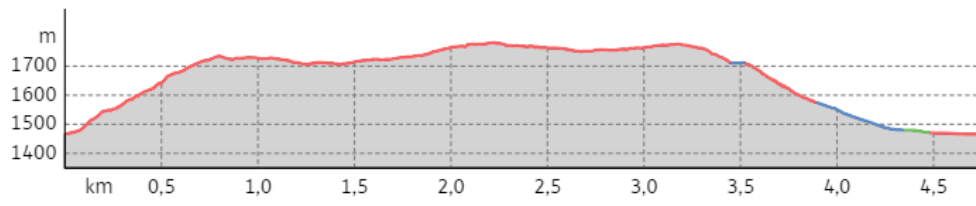
RUSTIC, BEAUTIFUL, AND HIGHLY SENSITIVE

- Level of difficulty:** Moderate summer excursion on well-developed paths with a destination above the valley floor; hiking or mountain shoes with a treaded sole required.
- Equipment:** Hiking or mountain shoes with a treaded sole, rain and sun protection, appropriate clothing and a change of clothes, backpack with drinks and snacks.
- Costs:** €22 for adults. Children and adolescents (10-16 years old) accompanied by their parents are free. Free with a guest card or Nationalpark SommerCard!
- Dogs:** The presence of dogs is not allowed during excursions out of consideration for other participants and local wildlife.
- Meeting point:** Summer Dates: Every Thursday (from July 11, 2024 to September 5, 2024) at 9:30 AM at the "Weißsee Gletscherwelt" valley station (47.16969, 12.62469).
Autumn Date: Monday, September 30, 2024 at 9:30 AM at the "Weißsee Gletscherwelt" valley station (47.16969, 12.62469).
- How to reach us:** By bus (Line 672) to the stop "Enzingerboden Weißsee Seilbahn Talstation"; alternatively, by car to the parking lot at Enzingerboden.
- Duration:** Approximately 4 hours.
Pure walking time: Approximately 3 hours.
Route: Approximately 5 kilometers.
Ascent: Approximately 300 meters in altitude.
Refreshment stops: Possibility for refreshments after the tour.
- Booking:** No registration is required for the summer tours—just arrive at the meeting point at the specified time, and our ranger will wait for the bus to arrive before starting promptly.

- Description:** Starting from the valley station of the 'Weißsee Gletscherwelt,' the hike leads through the primeval Wiegenwald up to the Schwarze Lacke. Visitors will learn interesting facts about plants, trees, and animals native to this region. Along the way, picturesque moor ponds invite you to linger. Magnificent views of the surrounding mountain world and their reflections line the path. The tour ends back at the starting point.
