

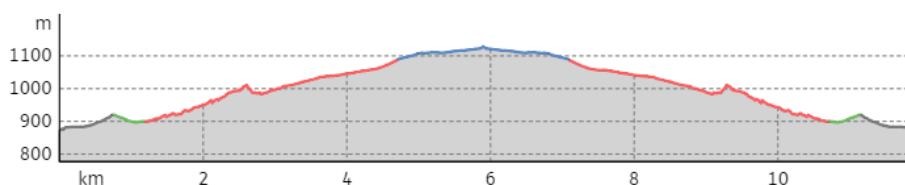
Schößwendklamm and Hintersee - Autumn Tour

Mosses, ferns, and lichens

- Level of difficulty:** Easy summer excursion on wide hiking trails.
- Equipment:** Sports or lightweight trekking shoes, rain and sun protection, appropriate clothing and a change of clothes, backpack with drinks and snacks.
- Costs:** €22 for adults. Children and adolescents (7-16 years old) accompanied by their parents are free. Free with a guest card or Nationalpark SommerCard!
- Dogs:** The presence of dogs is not allowed during excursions out of consideration or other participants and local wildlife.
- Meeting point:** Wednesday, 2nd October 2024, at 9:00 AM at the Schößwendklamm parking lot, a few meters after the turn-off from Felbertauernstraße. (47.22034, 12.48393).
- How to reach us:** Follow the Felbertauernstraße to the turnoff for Schößwendklamm/Hintersee. We will meet at the Schößwendklamm parking lot (47.22034, 12.48393). If you are traveling by public transport, get off at the "Felbertauernstraße Abzweigung Schößwendklamm" stop. The meeting point is approximately a 5-minute walk from the stop.
- Duration:** Approximately 4 hours.
- Pure walking time:** Approximately 2.5 hours.
- Route:** Approximately 8 kilometers.
- Ascent:** Approximately 250 meters in altitude.
- Refreshment stops:** available after the tour

Description: We will meet at the entrance to the Inner Felbertal, just a few meters after the turnoff from the Felbertauernstraße. Here, at the valley floor near the Schößwendklamm, water has been carving its way through the hard rock, composed of biotite, hornblende, and schist, for thousands of years. This has created impressive erosion forms, pools, and small waterfalls. We will follow the gorge to the Hintersee and learn interesting facts about the flora and fauna of the upper Felbertal, as well as some insights into the formation of the Hintersee. On the north side of the lake, we will follow the circular path to a ridge with a view over the valley end, where chamois can be seen, and then return along the same path to the starting point.
