

Seebachsee - Autumn Tour

Species-rich wet meadows, idyllic mountain forests, and alpine pastures

Level of difficulty: Challenging autumn excursion that involves steep terrain and is accessible via climbing paths.

Equipment: Hiking or mountain shoes with a treaded sole, rain and sun protection, appropriate clothing and a change of clothes, backpack with drinks and snacks.

Costs: €22 for adults.. Free with guest card or National Park Summer Card!
Due to the duration and altitude, this tour is not suitable for children.

Dogs: The presence of dogs is not allowed during excursions out of consideration or other participants and local wildlife.

Meeting point: Friday, 20th September 2024, at 8:00 AM at the Hopffeldboden parking lot (paid parking; 47.20671, 12.25167).

How to reach us: In Neukirchen am Großvenediger, follow the signs towards Sulzau until you reach the entrance to the Obersulzbachtal. From there, continue following the signs to the Hopffeldboden parking lot (parking fee).

Duration: Approximately 8 hours.

Pure walking time: Approximately 6 hours

Route: Approximately 15 kilometers.

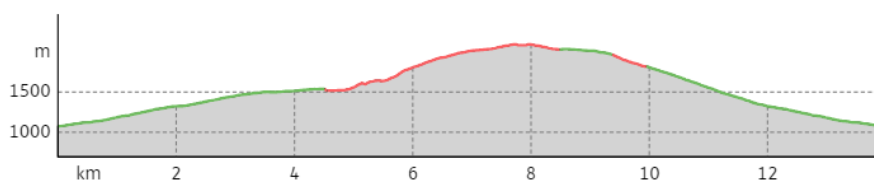
Ascent: Approximately 1050 meters in altitude.

Refreshment stops: Possibility for refreshments after the tour.

Description: Experience an unforgettable hike with a national park ranger! Start at the Hopffeldboden in Neukirchen and ascend to the Berndlalm. From there, continue over Poschalm and Munau, a species-rich wet meadow, through idyllic mountain forests to the picturesque Seebachsee at 2,083 meters elevation. Enjoy the tranquility and beauty of the mountain world while learning more about the local flora and fauna. The return route takes you through alpine meadows to Seebachalm and includes a circular path back to the starting point at the Hopffeldboden parking lot. This tour offers spectacular views and is perfect for nature lovers and hikers who want to explore the diversity of the national park!
